RULES

RULES CONTINUED

- The host clubs are encouraged to get U16 / Minor players to officiate in these blitzes
- Matches will be 10 mins played straight through
- Usual hurling rules but an accidental 65 will result in a puc-out. A deliberate 65 will result in a 20m free
- Teams should not have any more than 3 subs. If they have more these lads should be incorporated into other teams
